NJSEA Flyway Gallery Hosts “Homage to Mother Nature” During May and June

LYNDHURST, N.J. – The New Jersey Sports and Exposition Authority’s (NJSEA) Flyway Gallery will host an exhibit by Chang ‘Paul’ Kang shining a light on the everyday wonders of the environment around us during May and June. The show, “Homage to Mother Nature,” runs from Monday, May 4, through Saturday, June 20. An opening reception is scheduled for Friday, May 8, and a closing reception is set for Saturday, June 20, both from 6 to 8 p.m. The Flyway Gallery is located in the Meadowlands Environment Center in DeKorte Park.

Kang’s paintings of everything from delicate flowers and lush forests to snow-capped mountains and peaceful lily ponds reflect the artist’s deep love and appreciation for the beauty he sees in nature. A native of Korea and California resident, Kang’s work has been displayed in gallery shows throughout America and his home country, including the 33rd Annual Grand Art Exhibition of Korea in 2014.
