REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL:
AUDIT SERVICES

Notice is hereby given that the New Jersey Meadowlands Commission (NJMC), One DeKorte Park Plaza, Lyndhurst, New Jersey 07071 is seeking proposals to obtain the services of an independent public accounting firm for annual audit services for the years ending December 31, 2014, December 31, 2015 and December 31, 2016.

The Request for Proposal for these services will be available on the NJMC website at <http://www.njmeadowlands.gov/public/notices.html> and at the offices of the NJMC located at the above address beginning September 12, 2014 after 10:00 AM. All addenda will be sent via e-mail to interested parties and posted on the public notice section of the NJMC website. Anyone downloading a copy of this RFP from the NJMC website, as opposed to picking up a copy from the NJMC offices, is required to send a notice of interest to Mr. Edward H. Bulmer @ ed.bulmer@njmeadowlands.gov which should include company name, address, phone number and an e-mail address in order to receive any addenda.

Proposals will be received at the above address until 11:00 AM, prevailing time, on October 20 2014. Proposals will not be accepted after the above time and date.

A mandatory pre-bid meeting will be held at 11:00 AM at the NJMC offices on September 26, 2014. Proposals will not be accepted from bidders who fail to attend this mandatory pre-bid meeting.

In accordance with Public Law 2004, c.57, the NJMC may only enter into contracts with Bidders who provide proof of valid business registration with the Division of Revenue in the Department of Treasury, of the State of New Jersey. Such proof must be submitted concurrently with the proposal.

In order to insulate the award of state contracts from risk of improper influence, the NJMC shall only enter into a Contract with a Bidder who complies with Public Law 2005, C.51 and Executive Order 117. The required forms and instructions are included in the RFP.

NJMC reserves the right to reject any and all proposals and, so far as permitted by law, to waive any irregularity or informality with respect to any proposal. The NJMC further reserves the right to make such investigations as it deems necessary as to the qualifications of any and all firms submitting proposals. In the event that all proposals are rejected, the NJMC reserves the right to re-solicit proposals.
