SP-727 Notice of Readoption N.J.A.C. 19:7, District Transportation Rules

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the New Jersey Sports and Exposition Authority (NJSEA) is proposing to readopt, without change, N.J.A.C. 19:7, District Transportation Rules. The Notice of Readoption will appear in the December 21, 2015 New Jersey Register.

Pursuant to Executive Order No. 66 (1978) and N.J.S.A. 52:14B-5.1, the NJSEA proposes to readopt, without amendments, N.J.A.C. 19:7, District Transportation Rules, which will expire on January 6, 2016, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 52:14B-5-1c.

The NJSEA has reviewed the current chapter and determined that it remains necessary, reasonable, adequate, efficient, understandable and responsive for the purpose for which it was originally promulgated. The readoption is an administrative measure and no amendments are proposed.
