Watercolors, Pastels on Display at NJMC Flyway Gallery in January

LYNDHURST, N.J. – An exhibit of watercolors and pastels by local artist Mark de Mos and his students will be on display at the New Jersey Meadowlands Commission’s Flyway Gallery during January. The show, “Mark de Mos and Friends,” runs through Friday, Jan. 28.

“My goal, as an artist, is to produce art that is alive and that creates a drama, a feeling, a slice of life,” says De Mos, a Morristown resident. “As I paint I react to what is on the paper, and I can see the interesting color and tonal elements that will make it come to life.”

The exhibit features works by De Mos and his students – Anita Adelman, Keiko Matsuura, Tomoko Sugihara, Myrle Scott, Dottie Glen, Jane Stein, Erola Pellegrino and Joy Xie. De Mos is a member of several art associations, including the Allied Artists of America, the Garden State Watercolor Society and the Essex Watercolor Society.

De Mos’ paintings have won dozens of awards, been featured in several magazines and books, and displayed in galleries in New Jersey, New York, Connecticut, Pennsylvania and Maryland.

The Flyway Gallery is located in the Meadowlands Environment Center in DeKorte Park in Lyndhurst. The gallery is open from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday and 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. Saturday and Sunday. DeKorte Park encompasses one square mile of wetlands, nature trails and water views – framed by the New York City skyline – and is a great place for bird watching and enjoying nature in general.
