

PRIZE STRUCTURE

- The total purse is \$20,000 based on 200 entries. Prize awards will be adjusted according to the actual number of entries. All entry fees will be returned as prize money.
- Order of finish is based on highest accumulated pari-mutuel earnings.
- In the event of a tie, prize money for those positions will be equally divided among entrants involved in the tie.
- Top finisher qualifies for, and receives round-trip airfare and on-site hotel accommodations to, the Horseplayer World Series, Winter 2010, Orleans Casino, Las Vegas.

- \$10 minimum bet per race; \$100 maximum bet.
- Win and Place wagers [or combination WP, not to exceed maximum bet].
- One horse per race.
- Contestants keep all pari-mutuel winnings.

CONTEST RULES & REGULATIONS

- \$100 entry fee is **non-refundable** and **required** with **entry form**. An additional \$100 "betting card" purchase is required. Players may choose to pay the **non-refundable entry fee** by: 1) cash, 2) money order or cashier's check made payable to Meadowlands Racetrack. **Personal checks will not be accepted.**
- Entrants keep all pari-mutuel winnings.
- Entrants cannot add additional cash to tournament bankroll; doing so results in automatic disqualification.
- Entries accepted on a first-come, first-served basis.
- **Limit two entries per person.**
- Entrants must **bet 10 races minimum and 15 races maximum** from Gulfstream Park, Aqueduct and Tampa Bay Downs. Betting less than 10 or more than 15 races results in automatic disqualification.
- Win and place wagers only [or any combination WP, not to exceed maximum bet of \$100].
- One horse per race.
- The minimum bet is \$10 per race; \$100 maximum.
- Contest wagering allowed on Gulfstream Park, Aqueduct and Tampa Bay Downs races only.
- Using your contest betting card to wager in any pools other than win or place, or on any other simulcast signals, results in automatic disqualification.
- Players in the Top 25 on the leaderboard cannot withdraw their money until after the last contest race is official and a tournament official designates it is okay to do so. Withdrawing money before the last race is official results in automatic disqualification.
- Players must place all wagers personally. No person shall directly or indirectly act as an intermediary, transmitter or agent in placing wagers for the Player.
- All tournament wagers must be made on self-service terminals (SST's) using your betting card and pin number.
- In case of cancellation of a contest race or track due to inclement weather or other circumstances beyond our control, the Meadowlands reserves the right to end the contest or designate alternate contest race(s) or track(s).
- **Meadowlands will send one qualifier to the HWS.** The qualifier must be in attendance at the HWS on each day of the event. If the top finisher cannot attend, the next highest placing qualifier will earn a berth. Depending on a particular situation, Meadowlands, in cooperation with Coast Casinos, may assign an alternate qualifier. Players agree to abide by these determinations.
- Eligibility (e.g. employment or affiliation, family relationship, past winnings) may vary between HWS qualifying tournaments; however, eligibility of finalists for the Horseplayer World Series is established by Coast Casinos.
- **Players are responsible for obtaining live post time information.** Any post times provided with past performances are estimates only. The Meadowlands is not responsible for missed wagers due to adjusted post times.

- No cancellations on any wagers for any reason after post time. In the event of a late scratch, contestants must follow NJRC cancellation procedures.
- All official track rulings apply to horses selected for championship play.
- Meadowlands and Scientific Games Racing, LLC., are not responsible for "shut-outs," incomplete transactions, lost or mutilated betting cards, or mechanical failure of any tote machine used for contest wagering. No exceptions under any circumstances. All wagers should be placed early to avoid being shut out.
- **Raceworld Teletheater is the contest home base; all announcements will be posted here.**
- All questions or problems should be immediately reported to Tournament Directors in Raceworld Teletheater.
- The decisions of the judges and the NJSEA in all matters or disputes relating to this handicapping contest are final.

GENERAL RULES

- Must be 18 years of age or older by March 28, 2009 and have valid ID to register and participate in tournament. **Must be 21 years of age or older by January 1, 2010 to participate in Horseplayer World Series.**
- Winners are responsible for all applicable state and federal taxes & may be required to complete Form 1099.
- All participants agree to have their name or image appear in any publicity material (posters, newsletters, programs, etc.) and printed in any publication.
- Employees of the NJSEA and Scientific Games Racing, LLC., are not eligible.
- Licensed horse owners and trainers are eligible to participate, but are required to identify themselves, in writing, to tournament officials and identify any vested interest they have in any tournament race(s) by completing and submitting the provided declaration form.
- All horse owners and trainers are ineligible to wager, for tournament purposes, on any race in which they have a horse(s) competing, and/or any other vested interest.
- **Failure to notify tournament officials of any vested interest in race(s) eligible for wagering in this tournament, or wagering on any race where said entrant(s) has an interest, will result in automatic disqualification with no entry fee refund.**
- The NJSEA reserves the right to make changes to the contest rules and format as necessary.
