OFFICIALS TO LAUNCH NEW RAIL SERVICE TO THE MEADOWLANDS

Inaugural train ride to kick off new travel option for attending events at the Meadowlands Sports Complex

NEWARK, NJ – Governor Jon S. Corzine will accompany officials and guests on an inaugural train trip for NJ TRANSIT's new rail line linking Hoboken Terminal and the Frank R. Lautenberg Station at Secaucus Junction to the Meadowlands Sports Complex.

The trip will be capped by a ribbon-cutting ceremony at the new Meadowlands Rail Station, marking a new convenient travel option for customers attending major events at Giants Stadium.

- Departs Secaucus Junction at 1:40 p.m.
- Arrives at Meadowlands Rail Station at 1:50 p.m.

- **Hoboken Terminal:** There is limited parking available in the cobblestone area. Please check in with the NJ TRANSIT Police Officer upon arrival. (Due to limited parking availability, members of the media boarding at Hoboken Terminal are encouraged to get dropped off.)
- **Secaucus Junction:** Parking is available at the Edison ParkFAST lot, located off NJ Turnpike Exit 15X at New County Road and Seaview Drive.
- **Meadowlands Rail Station:** Parking will be available in lots 10 and 12 for guests who do not ride the train.
