

**MEADOWLANDS DISTRICT
SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN AMENDMENT**

The New Jersey Sports & Exposition Authority (NJSEA) will hold a Public Hearing on **April 15, 2015** at 10:00 a.m. in the NJSEA Board Conference Room concerning a proposed amendment to the Meadowlands District Solid Waste Management Plan (NJSEA PLAN) pursuant to the New Jersey Solid Waste Management Act, P. L., 1975, C.326.

Specifically, this Amendment concerns a proposal for a modification/expansion of the existing NY/NJ Recycling, LLC facility located at 800 Page Avenue, Block 235, Lot 23 in the Township of Lyndhurst, Bergen County, New Jersey from 100 to 200 tons per day. The proposed facility will be operated by NY/NJ Recycling, LLC and will be a modification/expansion of the existing Class A & B Recycling Facility on the property to solely a Class A Recycling Facility handling only paper and cardboard products. It is estimated that the facility will receive approximately 200 tons per day of Class A recyclables. The current expected percentage breakdown by weight is as follows: 30% - Newspaper; 15% - Office paper and high grade paper; 55% - Cardboard.

The proposed amendment, documentation and plans are available for review at the Commission offices during regular business hours. Written and/or oral testimony relevant to this Amendment will be accepted at the Public Hearing to be held on **April 15, 2015** at 10:00 a.m. in the NJSEA Board Conference Room, Second Floor, Meadowlands Environment Center, 2 DeKorte Park Plaza, Lyndhurst, New Jersey. Please contact the NJSEA Offices at (201) 460-1700 prior to the Hearing if special requirements are needed under the American's With Disabilities Act (ADA).
